ELIGIBILITY

This exhibition is open to all attenders of Atonement Lutheran Church, 14 years and older.

ARTWORK

Each exhibitor may show up to 2 pieces, as the exhibiting space allows. All artwork must be original and remain for the duration of the show. Artwork will not be priced for sale; interested parties may contact the artist directly.

Both 2-dimensional (paintings, drawings, photography, etc) and 3-dimensional (sculpture, ceramics, mosaics, fiber art, jewelry, etc) art work is allowed. All 2-dimensional artwork must be ready to hang with all appropriate hanging hardware. Artwork must be appropriate for viewing by all ages in a church venue.

SUBMISSION

Please send an image of the artwork along with the **TITLE, DIMENSIONS** (2-D artwork should include the framed dimensions), **MEDIUM or MATERIALS** by **August 7, 2017**.

Please also include a statement describing how the artist's work is connected to their life of faith: for instance, the artwork may have a religious subject or inspiration; or in a broader sense, the artwork may be an expression of the gift of God's creative Spirit in the life of the artist.
